

The first section of this document is the Errata, dealing with corrections or changes to the wording of rules. The second section of this document is the FAQs, providing clarification on how specific rules interact.

ARMIES OF GREAT BRITAIN - ERRATA

All instances of the Stationary Firing Platform rule

REPLACE the rule's wording with the following:

- Stationary Firing Platform: The vehicle may not fire if given an *Advance* order.

PAGE 22. Come On, Lads!

CHANGE the second sentence as follows:

The morale bonus of British Platoon Commanders and Company Commanders is increased by 1, but any cover save they and the men in their unit receive is reduced by 1.

PAGE 30. Airborne Section, Special Rules.

CHANGE the third bullet point as follows:

- LZ Signals (If Pathfinders option is taken): If at least one unit of Pathfinders is not in reserve (i.e. is deployed or in first wave), then any friendly Airborne unit in reserve may re-roll failed order tests to come onto the table from reserve. This includes Airborne Sections, Airlanding Rifle Squad, any unit upgraded to Airborne, Tetrarch and Locust tanks, and Airborne Recce Jeeps.

PAGE 32. Commando Subsection, Options.

CHANGE the third option as follows:

- Any model may replace their rifle with a submachine gun...

PAGE 39. Sniper Team, Special Rules

ADD the following:

- Infiltrator

PAGE 43. Light Artillery, Options.

CHANGE the third bullet point as follows:

- If taken as Airborne, it must lose both the Gun Shield and 25-pdr AT shell special rules for -20pts (75mm Pack Howitzer).

PAGE 78. Crusader III AA MK I & MK II, Options.

CHANGE the bullet point as follows:

- May replace the heavy automatic cannon with two turret-mounted light automatic cannons, losing the Open-Topped special rule, for +30pts, (making it a Crusader AA Mk II).

PAGE 81. Daimler Armoured Car.

ADD the following Option:

- May add a Littlejohn Adaptor to the light anti-tank gun for +10pts

PAGE 90. 30CWT Trucks.

ADD the following Option:

- May upgrade the LMG to a MMG for +5pts

In a unit with a mix of models with SMGs and rifles, can all of the additional attacks in close quarters from 'Fix Bayonets' come from the models (or even the one single model) equipped with SMGs, in order to benefit from the Tough Fighters rule?

Yes, any number of additional attacks can come from a single model in order to get those re-rolls from Tough Fighters. The Sarge is well 'ard!

Does Fix Bayonets work when assaulting vehicles?

Yes, as it does not just literally represent bayonets, it's more of an 'aggressive close quarters attitude'.

If a Commando Subsection has a Lieutenant, does the +1 Morale Bonus benefit from the extra +1 from the Come On, Lads! Rule? And does his presence reduce the cover save of the unit?

Yes, and yes.

The Army Special Rules state that SMGs for Commandos cost +3pts per man, but some units instead state that it's +5pts per man. Which is right?

Both! SMGs cost +3pts per man when a man replaces his rifle with an SMG, but it costs +5pts when given to a man that does not have any weapon (like the crewmen of team weapons like anti-tank rifles, mortars, etc.). So, the costs shown in all entries are correct.

If I take two or three Early War Motorcycle and Sidecars as the Platoon Command Vehicle option for an Armoured Platoon, can I give the Command Vehicle upgrade to all of them or just one?

Only to one Motorcycle per Platoon, even if that slot includes two or three of them.

In the SAS Jeep – North Africa, the 'Deflate Those Tyres' special rule mentions 'difficult ground'. Is that the same as Rough Ground?

Yes, it is.

In the Armadillo anti-aircraft vehicle, should the Stationary Weapon Platform special rule only apply to the automatic cannon?

No, the rule applies to the LMG as well to represent the improvised nature of the vehicle.

Is the minimum range of the Petard Mortar on a Churchill AVRE also halved?

Yes, its range is effectively: 36" (or 21-42").
